1. Analysis of Twelfth Night Acts 4-5:

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- o Discussion and analysis of plot/ character/ conflict/ theme/ setting/ point of view.
- o Discussion, analysis, and application of relevant techniques, in relation to the themes of love, deception, appearance versus reality, Loss, and Madness.
- o Discussion and analysis of relevant dramatic techniques:
 - situational irony,
 - dramatic irony, foreshadowing, juxtaposition,
 - symbolism and allusion, and genre.

in Memoriam”

Thematic consideration should be love and family relationship.

Application of the appropriate technique to the stories:
contrast/juxtaposition, point of view, motif, symbolism, foreshadowing etc
